After over a year of meeting every fortnight, it felt a bit strange on Sunday evenings, but in September JUMP returned meeting in person in Christ Church Rooms. We welcomed 5 new young people, all who has started in Yr 7 at Cockermouth or Keswick school and up until the end of November we had great fun being able to do activities again in person studying subjects related to things happening in the world around us, the session on CoP26 at the start of November was really good.

We were also extremely fortunate to be able to go to St Johns in the Vale in November, having been scheduled to go the weekend Covid lockdown started in March 2020 and then in November 2020 and then in March 2021 it was wonderful to finally be able to come together, the photos show we had great weather and great fun.

Then it came to the Christmas party and the end of another year, having started the year on zoom we also ended the year on Zoom with the Covid numbers rising we decided it best to meet online.
